Re: Annual Pursuit Analysis

Sir,

In accordance with Directive 3:16, Pursuit and Forcible Stopping Guideline's, I have completed an analysis of this departments pursuit activity. There had been one (1) pursuit of forcible stopping incident in 2021. I have attached the police pursuit incident report for closer review.

ANALYSIS:

There was one (1) Vehicle Pursuit initiated by our agency in 2021. This pursuit was compliant with the AG Vehicle Pursuit Policy as well as our departmental policy governing Pursuits and Forcible Stopping Guidelines. As a result, one individual had been arrested and charged with one (1) felony charge and seven (7) traffic related offenses. No crashes occurred resulting in damage to the pursued vehicle or third party vehicles. No officers, suspects or civilians were injured during the reporting period.

According to the available report the top speed of this pursuit was 101 mph. The total distance travel was 1/10th of a mile. The officer involved reasonably believed that the violator posed an immediate threat to the safety of the public. The officer gave signal to the suspect to stop which were ignored. Shortly thereafter the suspect came to a stop and surrendered to police.

There are no discernible patterns and trends identified.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Training twice a year on departmental pursuit policy, as well as bi-annual training on the Attorney General Guidelines concerning pursuit policy should continue with an emphasis of discouraging pursuits for minor motor vehicle violations. Administrative reviews of all pursuits should continue in order to uncover any deficiency's in training, modification of equipment or the need for disciplinary action. This analysis did not uncover a need for additional equipment or modification to existing equipment.
