RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MULLICA AUTHORIZING EXECUTIVE SESSION

WHEREAS, while the Sen. Byron M. "(1) Any matter which, by express provision of Federal law, State statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from public discussion." BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Municipal Clerk, at the present public meeting, shall read aloud enough of this resolution so that members of the public in attendance can understand, as precisely as possible, the nature of the matters that will be privately discussed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Municipal Clerk, on the next business day following this meeting, shall furnish a copy of this resolution to any member of the public who requests one at the fees allowed by N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 et seq.
