AN ORDINANCE THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MULLICA, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 34, PERSONNEL POLICIES

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Mullica has adopted a Personnel Manual to govern interactions with employees; and

**WHEREAS**, the Atlantic County Joint Insurance Fund and the Municipal Excess Liability Fund require the Personnel Manual to be reviewed every two years; and

**WHEREAS,** after said review by Township Officials and Labor Counsel, changes to the Personnel Manual are required.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED,** by the Committee of the Township of Mullica, County of Atlantic, Sate of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section I:** The underlying changes are the changes that are highlighted on the attached pages which are specifically incorporated into this Ordinance by this reference are hereby adopted and shall be placed and inserted in the Personnel Manual and the Employee Handbook of the Township of Mullica.

Further, any references to Business Administrator and/or Ralph Condo shall be replaced with Personnel Coordinator.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that** all other terms and conditions as set forth in the Personnel Manual & Job Descriptions shall remain in full force and effect and any applicable forms shall be updated to comply with the changes adopted herein.

#### **ORDINANCE #11-2025**

### AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MULLICA, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY CORRECTING AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 148 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE CAPTIONED "LITTERING"

WHEREAS, due to recent regulations established by the New Jersey Department of Protection and the New Jersey Pinelands Commission controlling Stormwater Management issues, the Township amended Chapter 148 of the Code of the Township of Mullica captioned "Littering" by adoption of Ordinance 2024-12; and

**WHEREAS**, due to a scrivener's error it is necessary to correct that Amended Ordinance which added a new Section captioned "Definitions".

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Mullica, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance 2024-12 amending Chapter 148 of the Code of the Township of Mullica captioned "Littering" is hereby amended to include a new Section captioned "Definitions" as follows:

### "Definitions"

**Person.** Any individual, corporation, company, partnership, firm, association or political subdivision of this State subject to municipal jurisdiction."

- <u>Section 2.</u> All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.
- Section 3. If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision or clause of this Ordinance.
- <u>Section 4.</u> This Ordinance shall only take effect after final adoption and publication as required by law and approval by the New Jersey Pinelands Commission.

### TOWNSHIP OF MULLICA ORDINANCE #13-2025

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 102, CONSTRUCTION CODES, UNIFORM, SECTION 102-3, FEES OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MULLICA, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Mullica wishes to amend Chapter 102, Section 102-3, to bring Construction Code Fees into compliance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MULLICA THAT, Section 102-3, [7] be amended as follows:

### § 102-3 Fees.

[7] The fee for roofing or siding work completed on structures of Group R-3 or R-5 shall be \$85. To be deleted.

### **ORDINANCE #12-2025**

## ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MULLICA CREATING A NEW CHAPTER FOR THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MULLICA CAPTIONED "BUSINESS REGISTRATION LICENSES"

WHEREAS, on a periodic basis the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Mullica reviews its present Ordinances, policies and procedures to determine if any changes, amendments or new Ordinances, policies or procedures should be enacted; and

WHEREAS, as a result of this process, it has been determined that a new Chapter should be included in the Code of the Township of Mullica captioned "Business Registration Licenses".

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Mullica, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey, as follows:

### Section 1. Definitions.

Unless otherwise stated, the following terms shall, for the purpose of this Chapter, have the meanings indicated in this section:

BUSINESS ENTITY- Any new or existing commercial business, trade, profession, occupation, or service conducted in the Township of Mullica.

BUSINESS REGISTRATION LICENSE- The license issued to any business entity.

PERSON- An individual, firm, corporation, association or partnership.

### Section 2. License required.

No person or business entity shall engage in or carry on any business, trade, profession, occupation or service, including any business entity licensed by the State of New Jersey or the government of the United States, unless a license as herein provided for shall have been first obtained by said person or business entity engaging in said business, trade, profession, occupation or service. All persons or business entities presently in existence and now required to be licensed, and not heretofore, licensed, shall apply for the license by December 15, 2025 to become effective January 1, 2026.

### Section 3. Application; display of license.

A. An application for a business registration license shall be made to the Township Clerk of the Township of Mullica, and the license shall specify, by name, the person, firm or corporation to which it is granted and the location at which such business, trade,

profession, occupation or service is conducted. Each application shall include the following information:

- 1. Name under which business is to be conducted.
- 2. Name and address of business owner.
- 3. Address of business.
- 4. Type of business.
- 5. Telephone number for the business.
- 6. State tax identification number, New Jersey Business Registration Certificate Number.
- 7. If the property is owned by applicant or leased. If property is leased, the name and address and telephone number of the property owner.
- B. The business registration license shall be conspicuously displayed on the premises where the business is conducted.

### Section 4. Compliance with land use regulations; zoning license.

Upon an application being made the Township Clerk shall provide a copy to the Township Zoning Official, who shall review the type of business entity and the location of the business entity to determine compliance with the Township Land Use, Development and Zoning Ordinance and if it has been issued a Certificate of Occupancy. If the business entity is in compliance with the Township Land Use, Development and Zoning Ordinance and has been issued a Certificate of Occupancy, a zoning license shall be issued and attached to the business registration license. No business entity may conduct a business, trade, profession, occupation or service without both a business registration license and zoning license.

### **Section 5.** Lease Termination Date, Renewals.

All business registration licenses shall be for a one year period from January 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup>. The business registration license shall be renewed each year from the date of issue to December 31<sup>st</sup>.

### Section 6. Fee.

On January 1 of each license renewal year, all business entities operating within the boundaries of the Township of Mullica shall pay a fee in the sum of \$75.00 for a business registration for that year. This fee shall license the businesses to be in good standing for a period from the January 1 issuance date. For any new business, the business registration fee shall be an initial fee of \$25.00 plus the one year business registration fee of \$75.00. Any business commencing initial operation in the Township on or after July 1 of any year shall pay the \$25.00 fee and one-half (1/2) of the licensing fee and such first-year license shall expire on December 31<sup>st</sup> of that year. A late fee of \$25.00 shall be paid to the Township for any renewal application submitted after January 31<sup>st</sup>.

### **Section 7.** Purpose of Fees.

The fees imposed for business registration are necessary to cover costs of administrative processing and investigative purposes.

### Section 8. License to be exclusive.

No person or persons shall be allowed to transact a business under any license granted pursuant to this Chapter except the business for which said license was granted.

### Section 9. Compliance; non-transferability.

- A. No business registration license shall be issued to any person or entity who has not complied with the laws of the State of New Jersey or the ordinances of the Township of Mullica as to regulations concerning the safety of the persons who may have occasion to use the premises, place or thing being licensed. Any person or business entity who fails to comply with any State law of the State of New Jersey or Township ordinances after due notice of the alleged violations shall be provided an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting by the Mayor and Township Committee on a date to be set by the Mayor and Township Committee. Following said hearing, if the Mayor and Committee have determined that the violation(s) have been proved, said license may be either temporarily or permanently revoked as the Mayor and Township Committee shall deem appropriate based on the violation(s).
- B. In no event shall a license be issued or renewed if the license holder is the owner of the real estate where the business is to be conducted if there are any property taxes or assessments or other fees due to the Township.
- C. No business registration license provided for by this Chapter shall be transferred from one person to another person and no license shall cover any other place of business other than that for which it was issued.
- D. In the event of a sale of a business, an expansion of the existing business use, a change in the existing business use, or a change in ownership, a new application is required to be filed with the Township Clerk and a fee of \$50.00 shall be paid to the Township in order to continue the business registration license for that year.

### Section 10. Non-applicability.

This Chapter shall not apply to:

- A. Persons who have a home office that is restricted to computer and telephone communications and does not create an increase in traffic in residential neighborhoods; or
  - B. The delivery of newspapers, magazines or periodicals; or
- C. Residents within the Township who utilize property for the selling of farm products locally grown within the Township.

### Section 11. Exemption from Fee.

Any corporation authorized to transact business by the Department of Banking in the State of New Jersey, or any corporation authorized to transact business by any Department of the Government of the United States, or to any person licensed to transact business by the State of

New Jersey or any Department, Board or Commission thereof, or public utilities, shall be exempt from all fees upon providing a copy of the valid license or certificate

### Section 12. Local Authority Designation for Enforcement.

The Local Enforcement Authority for purposes of ensuring compliance with an enforcement of all rules, regulations and requirements set forth in this Chapter shall be the Mullica Township Zoning Official, Code Enforcement Officer or authorized designee. Every person conducting a business required to be licensed shall permit entry to the Township Code Enforcement Officer and Zoning Official to ensure compliance with this Chapter and the laws of the State of New Jersey and ordinances of the Township. Any refusal shall be a violation of this Chapter and subject to the penalties set forth herein including suspension of the business registration license.

### Section 13. Violations and penalties.

Any person, firm, association or corporation violating any section of this Chapter shall, upon conviction before the Judge of the Municipal Court having jurisdiction, be subject to the following fines:

- A. First offense: \$150.
- B. Second offense: \$300.
- C. Any subsequent offense: \$500.

### Section 14. Business Insurance Registration.

- A. Business Insurance Registration is required. It is unlawful for any owner of a business to operate within the Township without first registering its Certificate of Insurance demonstrating proof of Liability Insurance for negligent acts and admissions in an amount no less than \$500,000.00 for combined property damage and bodily injury to or death of one or more persons in any one incident or occurrence. The Certificate of Insurance is required to be filed annually with the Municipal Clerk with the renewal registration fee.
- B. Any person who violates the terms of this Section is subject to a fine of not less than \$500 but no more than \$5,000 plus court costs.
- <u>Section 15.</u> All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, inconsistent with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.
- <u>Section 16.</u> Should any section, subsection, part, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, and to that end, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
- Section 17. This Ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication as required by law.

### RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER #2 FOR THE AWARD OF SITE CLEANUP 1801 COLUMBIA ROAD

WHEREAS, the Governing Body adopted Resolution #260-2024 awarding a contract to Northstar Marine, Inc. for the Site Cleanup at 1801 Columbia Road in the amount of \$136,600 and,

WHEREAS, during the course of the project it was determined that the project site is located in a previously unidentified flood hazard area, the location of the trash piles previously identified is inaccurate and the stockpiled material was misidentified and significantly underestimate in preliminary reports used to prepare bid specifications and project scope; and,

WHEREAS, Change Order #1 (Resolution 123-2025) was authorized for the additional work described above in \$91,626.00, which results in a change order in excess of the twenty percent (20%) change order threshold as determined by the Township Chief Financial Officer; and

WHEREAS, recent testing indicated the soil must be contained in order to comply with EPA regulations and the cost to comply will increase the contract by \$220,275.00 exceeding the twenty percent (20% change order threshold as determined by the Township Chief Financial Officer

WHEREAS, a Statement has been provided by the Township Chief Financial Officer confirming the exceptional circumstances to require the approval of this Change Order and the amendment of the Contract with Northstar Marine, Inc.; and

**WHEREAS,** funds are available for award of this Change order as set forth on the Certification of Funds attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Mullica that for the reasons set forth in the Preamble hereinabove and the attached Certifications to this Resolution, that it hereby authorized and approves Change Order #2 to the Contract with Northstar Marine, Inc. for the Site Cleanup at 1801 Columbia Road in the amount of \$220,275.00

WHEREAS, The Atlantic County Improvement Authority (the "Authority"), a public body corporate and politic constituting an instrumentality of the State of New Jersey (the "State") established and created under the provisions of the county improvement authorities law, constituting Chapter 183 of the Pamphlet Laws of 1960 of the State and the acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto (the "Act"), is authorized pursuant to the terms of the Act to provide public facilities, as such term is defined therein, within the County of Atlantic, New Jersey (the "County"), including financing for the construction of same; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mullica, New Jersey (the "Township") desires to construct a new municipal building/police department complex (the "Facility") on real property owned by the Township, located at 4528 White Horse Pike, Elwood, New Jersey ("Property"; and together with the Facility, the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Township requested the Authority's assistance in financing and constructing the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has agreed to finance the Project on behalf of the Township through the issuance of bonds, and any notes issued in anticipation thereof, and shall, in connection therewith, lease the Property from the Township and simultaneously lease the Property back to the Township pursuant to a lease purchase agreement; and

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2024, in order to finance the Project, the Authority issued its Township Secured Lease Revenue Project Note, Series 2024 (Township of Mullica Municipal Complex Project (the "2024 Note") in the amount of \$4,405,000 in accordance with the terms of a resolution of the Authority entitled "Resolution Authorizing the Issuance of Lease Revenue Bonds, Series 2021 (Township of Mullica Project), of The Atlantic County Improvement Authority and Determining Other Matters Related Thereto" (together with any amendments thereof or supplements thereto in accordance with the terms thereof, the "General Bond Resolution"); and

WHEREAS, in connection with the 2024 Note, the Authority and the Township entered into a Lease Purchase Agreement dated as of August 1, 2024 (the "Lease Agreement"), pursuant

to which the Authority acquired a leasehold interest in the Property from the Township and, upon completion of construction of the Facility, the Township will acquire a leasehold interest in same from the Authority; and

WHEREAS, under the Lease Agreement, and in accordance with Ordinance No. 4 of 2022, adopted by the Township on May 24, 2022, the Township is obligated to make general obligation lease payments to the Authority at times, and in amounts, sufficient to enable the Authority to make debt service payments on notes and bonds issued by the Authority to fund the costs of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the 2024 Note matures on August 27, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined to issue its Township Secured Lease Revenue Project Note, Series 2025 (Township of Mullica Municipal Complex Project) (the "2025 Note") in an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000 for the purposes of, along with unspent proceeds of the 2024 Note: (i) refunding the 2024 Note, (ii) paying additional costs of the Project, and (iii) paying costs of issuance of the 2025 Note (collectively, the "2025 Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee believes it to be in the best interest of the Township and the residents thereof for the Authority to issue the 2025 Note for the 2025 Project and the Township wishes to authorize officials of the Township to execute and deliver any and all documents required by the Township in connection with the issuance of the 2025 Note.

BE IT RESOLVED BY A MAJORITY OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MULLICA, IN THE COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Ratification of Prior Actions; Authorization to Execute and Distribute **Documents**. All actions taken by the Township, the Mayor, Township Committee, Township Administrator, Chief Financial Officer and the Township Clerk/Deputy Clerk prior to adoption of this Resolution in connection with the issuance of the 2025 Note are hereby ratified and affirmed. The Township's auditors, bond counsel, Township solicitor and municipal advisor are each hereby authorized to participate in the preparation of a preliminary Official Statement, the final Official Statement, the required Township closing documents, including the 2025 Note, and all other related closing documentation. The Mayor, the Chief Financial Officer, the Township Clerk and Deputy Township Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute, acknowledge and deliver any and all documents, agreements, instruments and certificates necessary in connection with the issuance of and sale of the 2025 Note and in connection with the 2025 Project. Upon the execution or acknowledgment and attestation of and, if required, the placing of the seal on the required documents, each of the aforesaid Township officials is hereby authorized and directed to (i) deliver the fully executed and acknowledged, attested and sealed documents to the other parties thereto and (ii) perform such other actions as such Township officials deem necessary, desirable or convenient in relation to the execution and delivery thereof.

SECTION 2. Tax Covenant. The Township Committee hereby covenants on behalf of the Township to take any action necessary or refrain from taking such action in order to

preserve the tax-exempt status of the 2025 Note as is or may be required under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended and supplemented, and the regulations promulgated thereunder (the "Code"), including compliance with the Code with regard to the use, expenditure, investment, timely reporting and rebate of investment earnings as may be required thereunder.

**SECTION 3.** Continuing Disclosure Agreement. If it shall be determined that it is necessary and appropriate for the Township to execute and deliver a Continuing Disclosure Agreement (the "Disclosure Agreement") for the benefit of the holders and Beneficial Owners of the 2025 Note to enable the underwriter for the 2025 Notes to comply with the requirements of SEC Rule 15c2-12, then the Mayor and the Chief Financial Officer are hereby authorized to execute and deliver the Disclosure Agreement in such form as shall be acceptable to the Township Solicitor and Bond Counsel.

**SECTION 4.** Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

	"(8) Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance, promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed at a public meeting." Subject to the balancing of the public's interest and the employee's privacy rights under South Jersey Publishing Co. v. New Jersey Expressway Authority, 124 N.J. 478, the employee(s) and nature of the discussion, described as specifically as possible without undermining the need for confidentiality are;
	"(9) Any deliberation of a public body occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the responding party or the suspension or loss of a license or permit belonging to the responding party as a result of an act of omission for which the responding party bears responsibility." The nature of the matter, described as specifically as possible without undermining the need for confidentiality is;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Township Committee of the Township of Mullica hereby declares that its discussion of the aforementioned subject(s) will be made public at a time when the public's interest in disclosure is greater than any privacy or governmental interest being protected from disclosure.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Municipal Clerk, at the present public meeting, shall read aloud enough of this resolution so that members of the public in attendance can understand, as precisely as possible, the nature of the matters that will be privately discussed.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Municipal Clerk, on the next business day following this meeting, shall furnish a copy of this resolution to any member of the public who requests one at the fees allowed by N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 et seq.
